

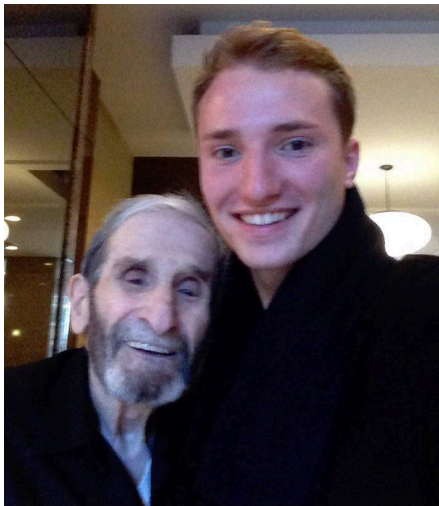

Soon our 22 German volunteers will head home after a year of service in the US. We invite you to take a look "behind-the-scenes" and join us for an exclusive visit at Selfhelp – Nazi Victims Services in New York. Selfhelp was founded by German émigrés in 1936 to help newly arriving European Jewish refugees fleeing from Nazi persecution find new lives in America. Selfhelp was among the first Jewish partner organizations of ARSP in the U.S. and has now hosted ARSP volunteers for more than 20 years.

ARSP volunteer David Wojahn will tell us what he takes away from the year and the work with Holocaust survivors who are in their 80's, 90's and even 100's. You will have the opportunity to hear from a representative of Selfhelp and one of David's clients what the encounter with young Germans mean to them.
